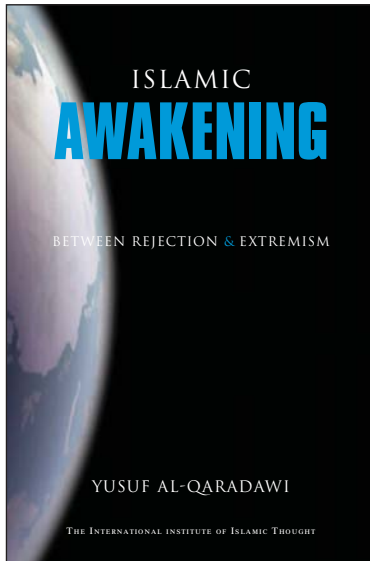

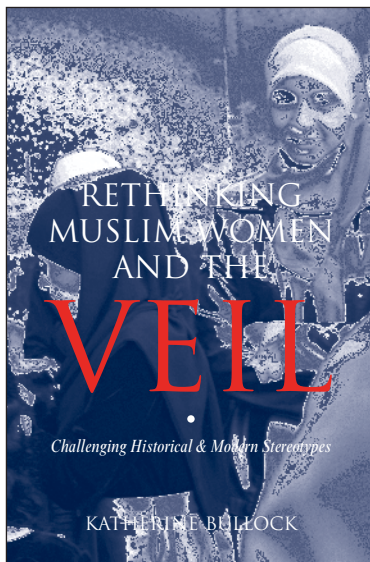


ISLAMIC AWAKENING: BETWEEN REJECTION & EXTREMISM

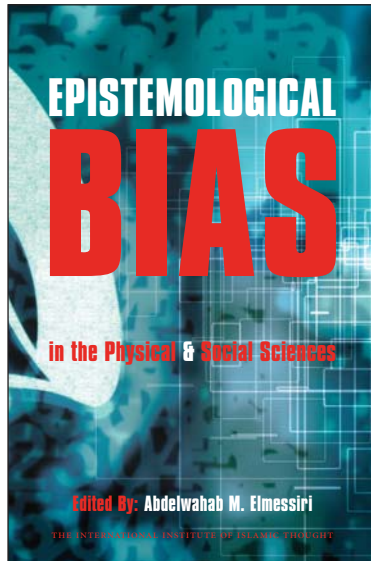


RETHINKING MUSLIM WOMEN AND THE VEIL

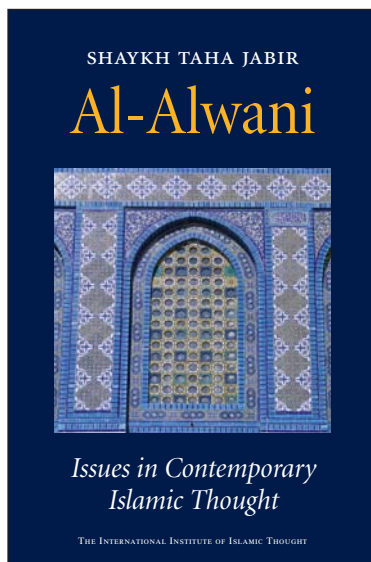
EPISTEMOLOGICAL BIAS: IN THE PHYSICAL & SOCIAL SCIENCES

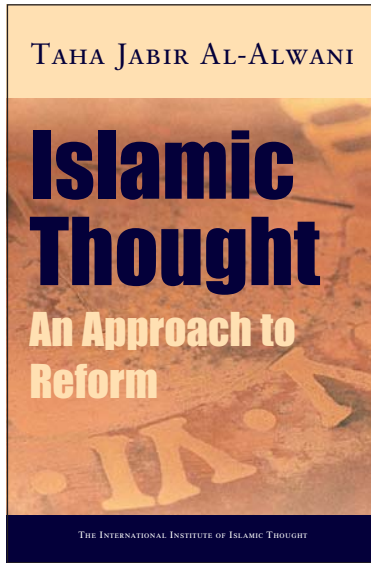

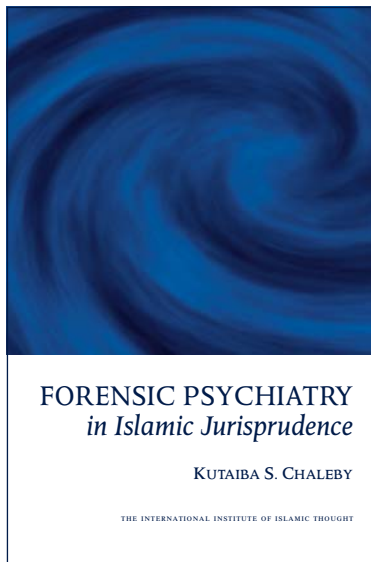

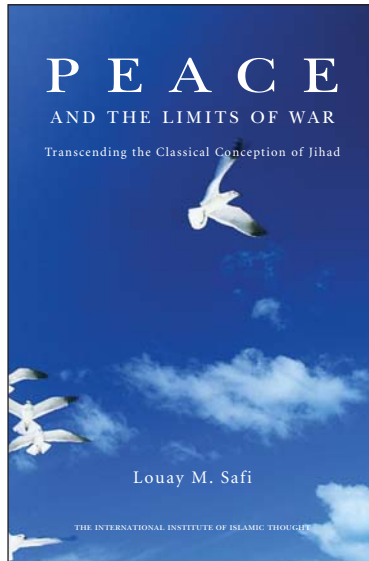
FORENSIC PSYCHIATRY IN ISLAMIC JURISPRUDENCE

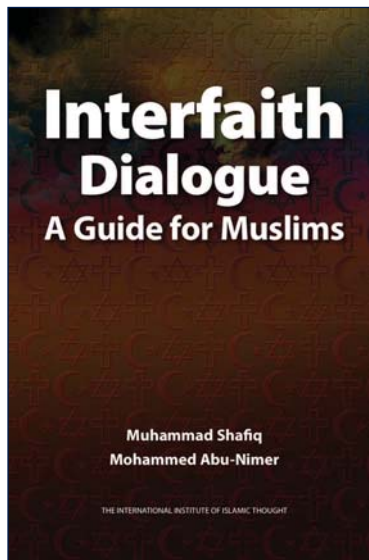


PEACE AND THE LIMITS OF WAR

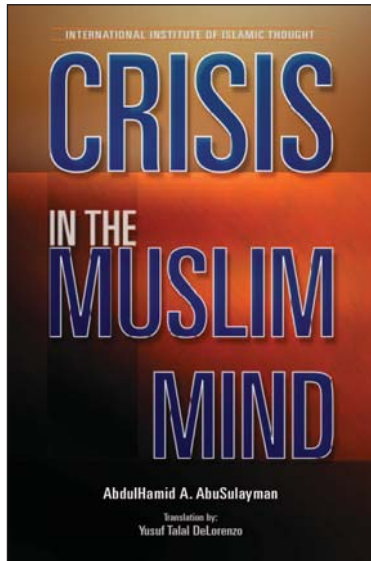


INTERFAITH DIALOGUE: A GUIDE FOR MUSLIMS

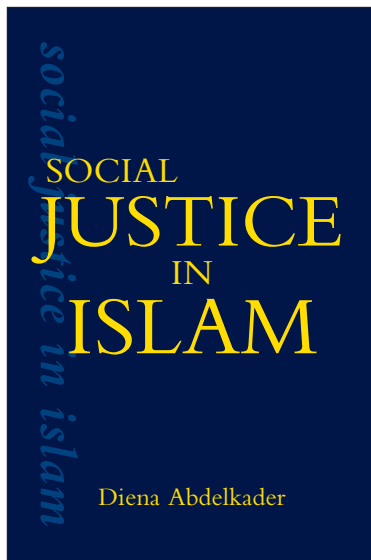
CRISIS IN THE MUSLIM MIND

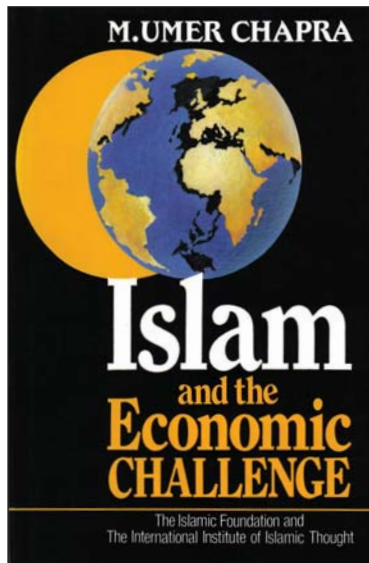
SOCIAL JUSTICE IN ISLAM
