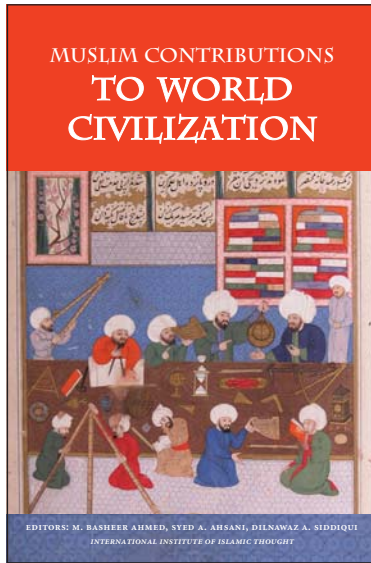

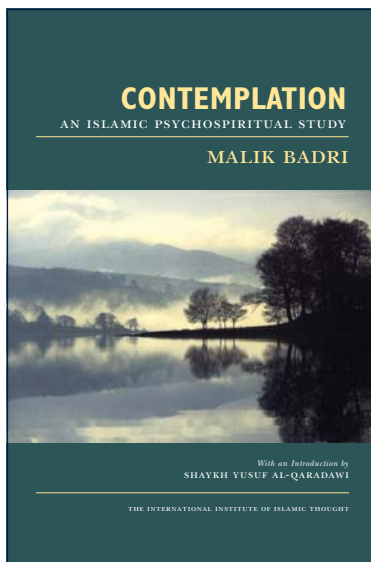

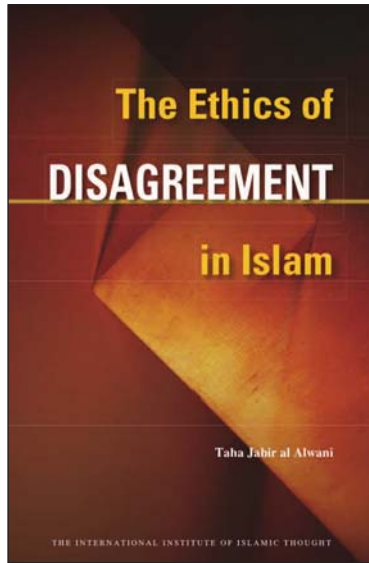


CONTEMPLATION: AN ISLAMIC PSYCHOSPIRITUAL STUDY

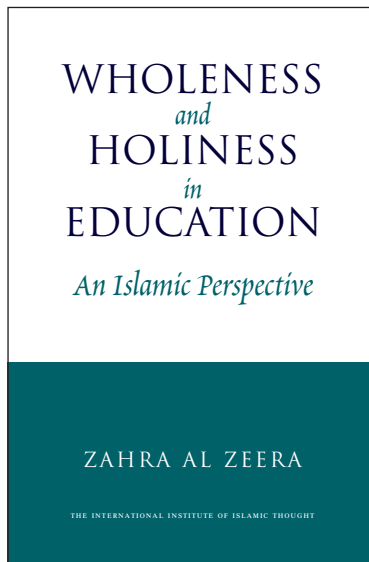


THE ETHICS OF DISAGREEMENT IN ISLAM

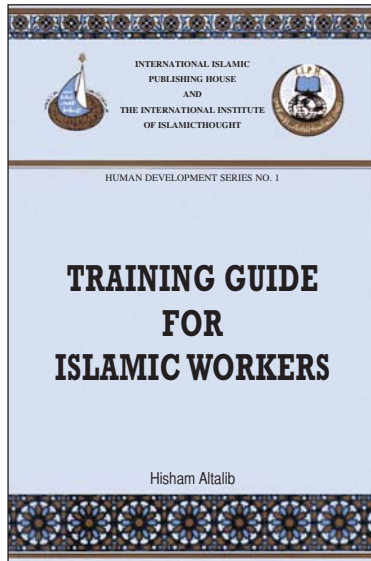
